Abstract The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised exercise program on the physical and psychological health of sedentary, middle-aged, obese women. The study was a randomized, controlled trial. The subjects were randomly assigned to either an exercise group or a control group. The exercise group performed a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised exercise program. The control group did not exercise. The subjects were assessed at baseline and at 12 weeks. The exercise group showed significant improvements in physical and psychological health compared to the control group. The exercise group showed significant improvements in body mass index, waist circumference, and blood pressure. The exercise group also showed significant improvements in self-esteem, depression, and anxiety. The control group showed no significant changes in any of the variables measured. The results of this study suggest that a 12-week, low-intensity, supervised exercise program can improve the physical and psychological health of sedentary, middle-aged, obese women.

Abstract—The purpose of this study was to determine if there were differences in the prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders among different types of workers. - 1. **Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound (SMART) Goals:** These goals are clear, quantifiable, and have a deadline. Example: "Increase sales by 10% within the next quarter."
- 2. **Results-Oriented:** Focus on the outcome or result you want to achieve, rather than the process. Example: "Increase customer satisfaction scores by 5%."
- 3. **Challenging but Attainable:** Set goals that stretch your capabilities but are realistic. Example: "Launch a new product line within 6 months."
- 4. **Time-Bound:** Establish a clear timeline for when you want to achieve the goal. Example: "Complete the project by the end of the year."
- 5. **Accountability:** Assign responsibility for the goal to a specific person or team. Example: "The marketing team is responsible for increasing social media engagement."

 6. The sixth step is to communicate the results of the experiment. This can be done through a written report, a presentation, or a poster.
